Option 1: Pay 10% of course price

This is available to:

- Under 18s
- Students (under 22 years of age), parents receiving income support, income-based job seekers allowance, income related employment support allowance, working tax credit or in receipt of support under part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999.
- Parents with a combined yearly household income of less than £16,190

Option 2: Reductions of up to 80%

This is available to parents with a combined yearly household income of £16,190 - £26,190

Option 3: Payment by instalments

You can pay for your course by agreed instalments as long as the final payment is made by the time that the course starts.
